Footnotes

DIRTY CERDAY set the pace along the inside down the backstretch, remained on a clear lead into the lane, extended inside the eighth pole then held. GALLANT was along the inside through the turn when getting closer to the pace, came off the rail into the lane while gaining momentum then could not gain on the winner while gaining the place spot. HALLELUJAH rated just off the winner through the turn, was well placed for the drive and lacked a response. CHABICHOU trailed through the turn while near the inside, came off the rail into the lane when gaining momentum then offered a belated rally. EDDIE ZANETTI was unhurried early while along the inside, remained close to the rail into the lane then gained belatedly. STAGE SUCCESS saved ground into the lane and lacked a rally. HOLY BULLHIVE chased the pace three wide into the turn then tired in the drive. MOUNT RAZMORE chased the pace from the four path into the turn and was empty in the drive.
