GENERAL BE was unhurried early while near the inside, moved quickly five wide into the lane and finished with good energy to edge to the front late. RICK'S TAVERN chased the dueling leaders into the lane, split rivals outside the eighth pole to gain a narrow advantage then could not hold. PLAY FAST vied for the lead along the inside into the lane, repelled challenger leaving the turn then was outfinished. BALLACOLLA was unhurried into the lane, angled to the inside when gaining momentum but could not sustain the effort. PHIL THE BRIT was unhurried into the turn moved four wide entering the lane, loomed a serious threat then flattened out late. K D MAC was never a threat while moving three wide into the lane. ILLINI MO vied for the lead into the lane while two wide then gave way.
