SWEET LITTLE DIXIE trailed the field early, swung into the six path in the turn, rallied in the stretch and drove past the leaders late under a steady drive. COWBOY CONTENDER tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. JACKS ARE LUCKY set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and yielded late in the stretch drive. TEE'S PROSPECT was unhurried early, while on the inside into the turn, made a bid in the stretch from the rail but faltered in the final stages. WALLSTREET CHARLIE stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late. SPURTABILITY chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn with no late bid in the stretch. FLAT OUT RICH swung into the six path in the turn while no threat. HEISWHATHEIS was never a factor. THERESNOJUSTICE showed little. CALL IN ADVANCE was never involved. ZYGLOW was done early.
