### Footnotes

**KELA'S BOY** stalked the two rival duel through the turn from the three path, bid into the lane, caught the leaders outside the eighth pole and drew away. **SCREENED OUT** vied for the lead along the inside, inched past the dueling challenger near the eighth pole then was no match for the winner while saving the place spot. **MY THUNDER** vied for the lead two wide through the turn then weakened in the final eighth. **USKA'S WALL CAT** chased the pace from the three or four path into the turn, bid four wide near the quarter pole to be in good position then flattened out in the lane. **WATCH FIRE** stumbled badly at the start then raced near the back and never factored. **SCHECTER** was done early while in the three or four path. **FAMILY SONG** was off to a slow start then raced in the four path through the turn and never was a threat.
