ARTICLE was unhurried early while off the inside, swung four wide into the lane when gaining momentum, continued with good energy in the lane to run down the leader, cleared late and was kept to the task while holding the runner-up safe. DEMI FLAME trailed into the lane while off the inside, fanned into the seven path for the drive and was closing in late from mid-track. UNA MAS CERVEZA sat behind four horse duel through the turn, moved three wide into the lane, gained the lead outside the eighth pole then could not hold off the top two. THE DUCK OF REED was unhurried through the turn, was blocked entering the lane dropping back to last, got through inside the eighth pole and was gaining. SHORT SALE angled into the six path into the lane and lacked a closing response. WHITEY WHITE CLOUD vied for the lead along the inside into the late turn then gave way. LATE CHARGE pressed the pace three wide through the turn then faded in the lane. THUNDERING SAM pressed the pace four wide into the lane then was empty thereafter. SOLO GLITTERS vied for the lead two wide into the lane then retreated along the rail.
