HOTROD HANNAH stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then took over command in the stretch and opened a bit of a clear lead then held off the rival in the final stages. GOGO JOJO was well placed early, swung into the six path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and made a bid late but did not have enough in the final strides. BELL OF BUDDHA broke in at the start then set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and yielded late in the stretch from the rail. COMMADORE KATE was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late. TAVERNIER BLUE hesitated and hopped at the start then trailed the field early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. PAOLI PRINCESS chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and was empty late in the stretch drive. NAJCAT broke slowly at the start and was no threat.
