CLASSICAL RHYTHM chased the pace from the two to four path through the turn, bid leaving the turn, caught the leader inside the eighth pole then drove clear. HALLELUJAH SQUARE bid three wide through the turn when gaining momentum, gained the lead outside the eighth pole then could not hold sway. STORMY ATLANTIS was unhurried early from off the rail, fanned into the five path into the lane then moved up while not a threat to the top two. MR. COACH trailed for half from off the inside, moved to the three path into the lane then found his best stride too late. ROOSTER DOWNS set the pace along the rail into the lane then gave way after straightening in the lane. REPORTERS DREAM raced in the three to four path into the lane then lacked a bid. MY THIRTY SIX was unhurried from off the rail then moved up through the lane. OCALA FREESTONE was in the two to three path while never far back then lacked a response. TEX AND THE CITY was through after going a half from along the inside. TAX CREDIT stalked the pace two wide into the turn then faded through the lane. TURBO JET EXPRESS was finished after traveling a half from off the inside. MR. JINGLES was in the five to seven path and steadily faded.
