**Footnotes**

SIR DAKOTA tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew away late under a steady drive. STRAIGHT SCOOTER was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn and just got up for place late. BIG REECE set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. ARROSON was reserved early, angled into the four path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. WEST ON WALLSTREET was well placed early, angled into the three path in the turn and lacked a late bid. LIFT HIGH THE FLAG bobbled at the start while on the inside into the turn and moved up in the stretch. JACKSON'S SPEED swung into the six path in the turn and improved position late. THE CASSTOWN CAT chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. CHANCE ELOPER was through after a half. IRON HOOOF was bumped at the start while no factor. BADDECK was never involved. HIGH SKY had early speed then retreated.
