Footnotes

HERSILIA stalked the pace three wide through the turn, bid leaving the turn, quickly gained a lead after straightening in the lane then drew away and was kept to the task to the end. VINTAGE CANDY chased the pace from the three path through the turn, was bumped while entering the lane then finished evenly to be well clear for the place spot while not a threat to the winner. TRIPLEDOGDAREYA was under pressure while setting the pace along the rail then yielded entering the lane. OFFICERS GLORY was along the inside through the turn and into the lane, angled off the inside out to mid-track and gained a piece of the show pie on the final stride. CALERA APPEAL tracked the pace along the inside into the lane,came off the inside entering the lane when gaining momentum, was forced out near the three-sixteenth pole, bumping rival then was empty. ROMAN INNOCENCE pressed the pace two wide through the turn then faded in the lane.
