RAFE HOLLISTER chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch and edged clear while holding off rival in the final stages. SOMETHING ALARMING was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn then was in tight inside the quarter pole and rallied quickly in the stretch but did not have enough late. CHARLIE'S PASSION was well placed early, swung into the six path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch run. EVANS THUNDER set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. HEZA WINNER TOO was back early, while on the inside into the turn and moved up in the stretch. GLADIATOR'S SWORD angled into the four path in the turn while no threat. MAJESTIC PRESIDENT tracked the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faded late. GET HOLME LARRY was never a factor. RED WHISPER was never involved. MARSH MANIA was through after a half. AHORSECALLEDAN showed little. BENAMINBABINS had early speed then folded up.
