DOCTOR MARK pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then bumped the rival hard in the stretch under a long drive and prevailed at the wire. K RUN vied for the lead early, angled off the rail into the far turn then was bumped hard twice in the stretch with a long drive and was outfinished late. MUCHACHO ALEGRE was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn with a late gain in the stretch run. NICKERS FOR CANDY chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch. NO CEASEFIRE had early speed then retreated. SINGING CHAMP was through after a half. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND A RIDERS OBJECTION, THE RIDER OF K RUN CLAIMED A FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF DOCTOR MARK FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH RUN BUT IT WAS DISALLOWED.
