WESTERNONE pressed early then took over command, angled into the three path in the turn then drew clear in the stretch and held in the final stages. MAMA DECIDES was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn then rallied in the stretch but missed late. ROWDY STELLA set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. PETTICOAT LANE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. LUCKY MAGEE was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn and was empty in the stretch. JOE'S RISING STAR was never a threat. RIVA'S DISPUTE was through after a half. ODE TO JEB showed little. THE LADY ISA CHAMP was done early. HI JULIE was never a factor.
