MOMENT OF SONG sprinted clear then widened at every call while being kept to the task. COUP was unhurried early, bid through the turn from the three path, fanned into mid-track for the drive and was gaining. UN GALITO (ARG) was unhurried early, bid along the rail in the lane and gained the minor share. PUBLIC DOMAIN stumbled at the start and dropped several lengths behind, came widest into the lane and was gaining. FAVORED SWEEP was never a factor from along the inside. BRAVE MINER chased the early pace then tired. INDY ENERGY raced in the three path through the turn when well placed then had nothing. SPEED GUN chased the pace from the inside then tired. TRUE MONARCH was through early from off the rail. CAPTAIN LARKIN was steadied on the turn from between rivals then dropped back.
