Footnotes

CHIEF TALKHEETNA set the pace from the four or five path through the turn, remained in mid-track for the drive and held while being kept to intermittent urging. MOYER'S POND chased the pace from the three or four path into the lane then offered a mild gain. I. M. BOOMER was bumped soon after the start and forced into rival, raced in mid-pack into the lane and lacked the needed response. BLUE CHERRIES SPIN was four or five wide through the turn, fanned into the eight or nine path in the lane and moved passed tired ones late. FATHER JOHN pressed the pace three wide through the turn and tired in the lane. ROCKERFELLER pressed the pace two wide into the lane and was empty. SAHMMY DAVIS JR was in the five path through the turn, came into the nine path for the drive and never factored. HOLY DREAMER was in tight early, steadied and hustled up to be in contending position then tired. AZICHARMYOU was along the inside into the lane and was empty.
