BROTHER JAMIE set the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn then drew clear in the stretch and shortened inside the sixteenth pole but held off rival late. GEORDIE chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and was gaining on the winner late. SLIVER was back early, angled into the three path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. TENMOR broke awkward from the gate, angled into the three path in the turn with a late gain in the stretch drive. DR. BUFFINGTON was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn with no late bid in the stretch. THOUGHT I COULD was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn with some gain in the stretch. JUST WATCHME SARAH angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. SKY AND ELI was through after a half. BRENT'S BAD BOY tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and then retreated. INDIANA GOLD showed little.
