G G GAL settled off the pace while off the inside, bid three wide into the lane and just got up after an extended drive. STRAWBERRY QUAKE was off to a clear lead into the first turn,remained clear into the lane and managed to have her largest advantage then could not hold on. FAST BOBBI J settled off the pace while off the inside, moved into the lane from the five path then finished willingly to just miss both of the top spots. STRAVLOVA was near the inside into the far turn, moved into the three path into the lane and was gaining. GIVEN A ROSE chased the pace along the rail down the backstretch and into the turn then needed more of a response through the lane. FLYING ROSSETTA chased the pace into the lane while in the three path then lacked a closing effort. LIZZIE BELLE was in the three or four path through the turn and never factored. SMARTY PARTY was put in tight moving past the grandstands the first time, clipped heels and checked to the back and never contended thereafter. BRILLIANT BRASS was in tight at the start, hustled up into the turn then steadily dropped back.
