QUIET BY SEVEN settled off the early pace while off the inside, bid five wide in mid-turn, swept past the pacesetters into the lane to clear and was all out to hold off the runner-up. CLONTARF stalked the pace from the three path into the turn, was moving up to challenge the pacesetter in late turn when the winner suddenly rushed past and cleared, then steadily gained on that one and ran out of real estate. SPACE OF TIME bumped at the start, bid four wide near the quarter pole then could not keep up to the top two while clear for the minor share. TRUE STARLET chased the pace from the two pat into the turn, was moving to engage the pacesetter when others moved up to the outside, steadied near the quarter pole and dropped back and never contended thereafter. DISTORTED ALICE was never a factor while along the inside. ISABELLE'S THUNDER was in the three path while not far back, was asked for more into the lane and tired. TREE HUGGER set the pace into the turn and gave way entering the lane.
