Footnotes

WATWOE set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then drew clear in the stretch and held late. MAJESTIC PRESIDENT chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. SEEYOUINAHUMMER stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. CHECK THIS ORDER was on the outside early on, stayed in the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. JACOBS SHADOW was on the inside into the turn and faded late. MILTONSHARPSHOTER pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and was empty in the stretch drive. DONTSTOP ONGREEN was done early. MAYOR PIKE broke awkwardly at the start and was no factor. WHATA WAKI showed little. MANN'S LUCKY CHARM trailed the field throughout.
