SILVER GRITS was unhurried from the three path, fanned into mid-track for the drive and was all out to run down the leader. PARADE BOLDLY bid from the three path into the lane, caught the leaders near the eighth pole, gained a lead soon after, remained on the lead inside the sixteenth pole then was caught in the final stride. FONTAZIA set the pace along the inside and weakened in the final eighth. JEFF THE CLOCKER trailed for half then rallied through the lane belatedly. CIRCUIT TAP was never a threat while moving up through the lane. EAGER WISH chased the pace from the two path into the turn then tired in the lane. SPORT CAT was along the inside into the turn, fanned into the six path for the drive and was never a factor. FASTCARS N FREEDOM chased the pace from the three path then tired. CALL NEW YORK was outrun while off the inside. BOYDSTWOMEN was outrun from the three to five path.
