Footnotes

THREE TICKETS tracked the pace from along the inside into the turn, gained a short advantage in mid-turn, remained on a short lead with an eighth to go then was all out to last. THE UNBELIEVABLE was in the two path through the turn when moving closer, floated to mid-track for the drive and was closing in. HOLY HUMOR vied for the early lead from the two or three path, was passed on the turn then came again and was closing in on the winner while being outfinished for place. HOOCHED EXPRESS chased the pace along the inside through the turn, cut the corner entering the lane, appeared a serious contender with an eighth to go then hung late. DENIM was in the three or four path into the lane then lacked a rally. ESCHEW OBFUSCATION stalked the pace three wide into the turn, bid into the lane then weakened in the final eighth. WATERSHED EVENT was never a serious threat while trailing throughout.
