QUEEN AN E set the pace into the lane from just off the rail then slowly widened through the lane. LA ESCONDIDA bid from the two path through the turn, moved closest to the winner in the lane then was no match for that one while finishing second best. GINGER CREEK raced in the three path through the turn, fanned into mid-track for the drive and rallied for the minor share. MISS LEATHERWOOD was five wide through the turn,fanned into the seven path for the drive and moved up while not a threat. TASTE SWEET raced along the inside, was in good position turning into the lane then weakened. PRESIDENTIAL ROSE pressed the pace from near the inside and weakened. LULABELL was never a factor while three wide through the turn. GEARED was never a menace while racing four wide through the turn. RIZZI DANCER was never a menace from the three path. HARLEY COUNTRY chased the pace from the three path then faded. HOURMISSREMY was in the four path through the turn, fanned into the eight path in the lane and was never a threat. MISS BATTLEAXE was outrun near the inside.
