Footnotes

I'M SO LUCKY settled off the early pace while in the three or four path into the turn, bid four wide into the lane, caught the leaders outside the eighth pole and drove past. FISH chased the pace from the three path through the turn, was attempting to move with the winner into the lane when the winner got to the four path first, had to move to the outside and gained the place spot without being a threat to the winner. HANCHO raced in the two or three path through the turn and offered a mild gain through the lane while never a serious threat. REDDICK TOWNSHIP vied for the lead two wide into the lane then weakened the final eighth. FIRST TRUMPET vied for the lead along the inside into the lane then gave way. TALBOT was outrun while in the three path through the turn. X MARKER was away alertly to gain the lead at once, remained on the lead before the first call then dropped back through the turn and was pulled up inside the eighth pole and vanned off.
