Footnotes

POLITICAL RACE settled off the early pace while off the inside, advanced through the three path on the turn, bid three wide into the lane, moved to the leaders near the eighth pole and drove past soon thereafter and was kept to the task to the end. MYSTERIOUS NOISE was unhurried while along the inside through the turn, moved up in the lane from the two path and showed best stride late. B B THE KING was in mid-pack into the turn while in the three path, fanned into the five path for the drive and offered a mild bid. LORENZO'S FOREST vied for the lead along the inside into the lane, repelled dueling challenger inside the eighth pole then was steadied briefly near the sixteenth pole when the winner drifted in and lost the show spot on the final stride. QUARTERBACK SACK pulled to vie for the lead down the backstretch, remained on the front end into the lane then weakened. CLEAR BOARD was near the inside into the lane and tired. ACEINTHESKY stalked the dueling pacesetters three wide into the turn then was empty in the lane. WELL WHAT was outrun from the three path. BIG STAGE was outrun throughout while near the rail. BAIL BONDSMAN was in the four or five path through both turns and had nothing in the stretch run.
