**Footnotes**

PRINCESS COMPOSER stalked the pace from off the rail down the backstretch, took over from the tiring pacesetter into the turn, moved to a clear lead before entering the lane then widened under a drive. LINDA'S LACE chased the pace two wide into the lane, could not gain on the winner through the final eighth while holding the place spot. CASE CHASER was unhurried into the lane, fanned to mid-track for the drive and offered a belated gain. CRIMSON DANCER chased the pace, bid three wide through the turn then weakened in the drive. U GOTTA BE KIDDIN raced three wide into the lane and was never a factor. IMA TRICK GENERAL was never a factor while in the three path. LICKETY SLICK was outrun while coming four wide into the lane. RISKY AGREEMENT raced along the inside and tired. TRANQUILITY STAR set the pace for half then retreated.
