### Footnotes

IMPERIAL FAX stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew away late under a steady drive. KAYLEE SHAE trailed the field early, swung into the six path in the turn with a belated gain in the stretch while no match for the winner. EXCESSIVELY BRIGHT set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then faltered late in the stretch. BRITTANYS AN ANGEL chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and was empty in the stretch drive. MORGANSMOONSHINE stumbled at the start and was bumped, angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. ZEALOUSLY was never a factor. WHATABOUTMILLIE was through after a half. SLEW'S GRACE was bumped at the start and done early. STYLN BONNIE had brief speed then folded up. WAVE LAND KELSEY showed little.
