Footnotes

FLOPPER raced four wide through through the turn when close to the lead, continued with momentum into the lane, gained the advantage inside the eighth pole and cleared for the lead then was all out to last. BROKE BUT STYLIN settled off the pace through the turn while in the three path, fanned into mid-path for the drive and finished with good energy to just miss. BUCK ONE was unhurried early from off the pace, fanned widest into the lane and offered a mild bid. A DASH OF GREY pressed the pace three wide through the turn then weakened in the lane. SENATOR JOE P. raced in the three or four path through the turn and was never a factor. STARS 'N DREAMS set the pace into the turn from along the inside then tired. HAZZARI was never a factor from near the inside. TRICKY SECRET faded along the inside. SWEET WATER RIM dueled for the lead two wide and between rivals through the turn then retreated.
