SEFAS ANGEL settled behind the three horse duel into the turn angled off the inside leaving the turn, moved to the three path for the drive and just got up. BETCHA I CAN was unhurried while in the three path, moved four wide into the lane and was finishing with good energy but was outfinished by the winner. CINDARELLA GIRL settled early while off the rail, made a big sweeping move through the turn to open up a clear lead then could not hold off the top two. PIAGET SYMPHONY was unhurried early while never far back, raced into the three path in the lane then offered a mild bid. LA NEGRA MODELO was in the three or four path throughout and was never a factor. RED HOT MISSILE was unhurried early, bid five wide into the lane then leveled out. DALADY pressed the pace two wide into the turn then tired. DIASCIA pressed the pace three wide into the turn then faded through the lane. LINDA'S LASS set a pressured pace into the turn then faded along the inside. LEMHI LIGHTNING was outrun from the four path. C B T DAN'S GIRL raced close up for half then steadily dropped back through the turn.
