DARK OBSESSION was away alertly, cleared the field entering the turn, widened into the lane then was kept to the task to maintain a diminishing advantage. GRAND THEFT raced three wide through the turn when not far back, fanned into mid-track in the lane then was closing in late. BEAUTIFUL VISION chased the pace from the two path through the turn then lacked a closing bid through the lane. DESTINY'S YIELD chased the pace from the two path into the lane then weakened. MOLLY'S EVENT saved ground into the lane then moved up along the rail. PEERLESS NOTE was never a factor from off the rail. NEW DIGS faded along the inside. FIVE K was through early from the three path. YUMMY IN DA TUMMY raced close up early then retreated while near the inside. NEW JOYZEE raced three or four wide through the turn and was never in it.
