VEGAS JACKPOT chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch with a long drive and edged past in the final stages. BURNING BUSH stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn while making a bid with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. PRINCINI was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. ANGEL'S CAN BOOGIE set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch. BODYNE angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late. ROLL ON ROUGE was never a threat. LANGALEER was never involved. YOUTH'S PRIDE was done early.
