SHERRY'S TIGER stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then took over command in the stretch and cleared the field late. LEMON CRUNCH tracked the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. MESA ROSE chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but faded late. THIS WAY HOME was well placed early, swung into the six path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch. MISS ZIGGY angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but was tired late. CLEAR CUT was through after three quarters. NOLA STAR set the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then gave way in the stretch while drifting out late. JUDY FREE BIRD broke slowly from the gate and bobbed early, outrun.
