Footnotes

PLEASANT AFFAIR set the pace along the inside into the turn, shook off challenger in mid-turn, widened into the lane then was never seriously challenged to the end. RED RONCHO settled off the pace while in the three or four path, bid four wide into the lane and was gaining to be second best. GLAD CAT chased the winner through the turn from the two or three path and needed ore in the drive. D'WOP D'WOP was into the lane from the five path and offered a mild bid. YARDBIRD MISFITS was along the inside through the turn, came off the inside in the lane and finished evenly. GABBAZOE was gaining momentum late in the turn from the three path when checked hard, angled to the inside and never offered a serious run. SEA'S TAFFY was along the inside through the turn, shifted to the five path for the drive and had little to offer. MEAN MARINE chased the pace three wide through the turn and was empty in the lane. RETURNING RAIN was away alertly to gain the lead at once, led for the first eighth, was up entering the turn then faded while four wide. SCOREKEEPER was outrun from the three path through the turn.
