**Footnotes**

KILLENAULE GREENE was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and was flying late then edged past the leader in the final stages. CONSUMED tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command and opened a bit of a clear lead but was ran down in the late stages. ERIN'S CHARGE set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch run. BETTER WATCH ME stalked the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. TAILGATING chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and was empty late in the stretch. WALLSTREET FLASH was well placed early, angled into the three path in the turn and never rallied in the stretch. WIN CASTLE was never a threat. OCEAN AFLEET showed little. ORIENT FORTY was done early. MABEE A DREAM was never involved. LUCKY LEON stumbled at the start and fanned into the eight path in the turn.
