TIME TO GETIT was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn, rallied in the stretch and drove past in the final stages. SCRIMP N ONTHENEWS was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn, rallied in the stretch but missed late. HOLD'EM OR FOLD'EM pressed the pace early while three wide, angled off the rail in the turn, split horses inside the eighth pole, took over the lead but was caught late. SAUCY'S IMAGE vied for the lead early while four wide, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. DELTA CHARLIE was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch run. RON'S PERENNIAL dueled early while on the inside into the turn and gave way in the stretch drive. PALM SPRINGS dueled early from between horses, while on the inside into the turn and faded late. ZULU MAGIC was done early.
