Footnotes

DIABLO'S DIAMOND was unhurried early while in the three path through the turn, gained momentum from mid-track in the lane and finished with good energy to be up in time. SPECIAL BELLA set the pace while on a clear lead, continued with the lead in deep stretch and was caught in the final strides. THEDEVILMADEMEDOIT chased the pace from the two path into the lane then lacked a bid late while well placed. G GS GOT THE GOODS settled back into the turn, was roused in mid-turn and began gaining from the three or four path into the lane and offered a belated gain. BATESBURG was never a serious threat while racing along the inside. MANNIE'S CUPCAKE tracked the pace along the inside into the lane, was well positioned with an eighth to go then faded. LADY BALTIMORE was never a factor while in the four or five path into the lane. GOOD SILVER BULLET was through after going a half from the two path. BRUJO BETTY was outrun while in the two or three path throughout. MISS BRIANNA was outrun along the inside. MICAHS A TOMBOY lunged at the start, hit the gate and lost an iron, raced at the back of the pack and lost all chance.
