Footnotes

YAROSLAV was unhurried early while saving ground, continued on the inside into the lane, waited inside the eighth pole, angled four wide outside the sixteenth pole and quickly drove past. MCBURNS was unhurried early while off the inside,bid three wide into the lane, caught the leaders near the eighth pole then was no match for the winner while clear for the place spot. POTENTIAL vied for the lead along the inside into the lane, gave way to the runner-up and was all out to save the show spot. INTI (URU) raced four wide through the turn then moved up while not a threat in the lane. BIG REDS LIL FLYER vied two wide into the lane, was bumped when tiring near the eight pole. BIG BEAR HUG chased the pace from the four path into the lane and weakened. M'NAUGHTEN was in tight through the first turn,steadied, raced along the inside into the lane then faded.
