STAKES William Henry Harrison S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR REGISTERED INDIANA SIRE, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$84,000 added. After paying 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth to last, purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 116 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$21,000 in 2011-2012 allowed 3 lbs; Non winners of \$14,400 twice in 2011-2012 other than maiden or claiming allowed 5 lbs; of such a race in 2011-2012 allowed 7 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner. NOTE: This stake will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 horses pass the entry box preference will be given to those with the highest weights. Second preference will be 2011-2012 earnings. Entry fee only will be refunded if failure to draw into the race. (S)

Footnotes

SEAPOPS stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch and was just up at the wire. PASS THE CROWN tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then led late in the stretch but was caught at the wire. UNREACHABLE STAR trailed the field early, angled into the four path in the turn then rallied in the stretch but did not have enough late. MOTOWN BOY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. T. L. SENSATION was never a threat. MR ROOSTER stumbled at the start then was rushed up and eventually spent.
