Footnotes

WALLACE STATION was settled off the pace early while on the inside into the far turn then rallied in the stretch from the rail and drew clear late under a steady drive. JUDITH'S LAKE was unhurried early, floated four wide into the far turn but was no match for the winner in the stretch drive. RAHY'S CHANCE stalked the pace early from the outside, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a move in the stretch run but had no room inside the eighth pole then weakened late. BIG BLUE SLEW was back early, angled into the five path in the far turn with a mild gain in the stretch. DUSTY OL' COGNAC was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn but couldn't sustain the bid in the stretch. BALLACOLLA tracked the pace, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid but faltered in the late stretch. PONTICIELLO (CHI) was never a threat. DIAMONDLUV set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way readily.
