Footnotes

CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE tracked the pace early while three wide, stayed in the three path in the turn, took over command in the stretch and cleared late under a steady drive in course record time. YANKEE INJUNUITY stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. HANDS ON dueled early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. DUE DATE was well placed early while on the inside into the turn and flattened out in the stretch run. EBBTIDE was settled off the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn while making a bid but weakened late in the stretch. ALL ON THE LION was no real threat. MY PRIVATE LAKE dueled early, angled into the three path in the turn, was in tight inside the quarter pole, steadied briefly and faded late. CHOSEN CHIEF angled into the five path in the turn while no factor.
