LITTLE MISS DIXIE was away alertly to gain the pace at once, widened entering the lane and was ridden out through the final eighth. MY FRIEND ANN was in the four path through the turn, came four wide into the lane and moved up to be second best. MOR THAN THE REST chased the winner from along the rail into the lane and lacked a closing bid while holding on to the show spot. BETONABETTY was in the three or four path into the lane and lacked a serious bid. BRASH CALICO chased the pace from the two path into the lane and faded. ORANGE LAKE TOO was in the three or four path through the turn then moved up while never a threat. MRS. T steadily faded along the inside. LIL BRIDESMAID was ridden hard early to try to get in contention then was finished in mid-turn. SEA YOUINTIME was always outrun while along the inside. HAY BAYBAY HAY steadily faded from the three path.
