Footnotes

MR. WATT tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then took over command, lost the lead but came again late while bumped late and edged past the leader in the final stages. BAD BRAD chased the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then drew clear in the stretch and bumped a rival late while caught in the final stages. ASSIPATTLE set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. WAAQAAD was back early, while on the inside into the far turn and moved up in the stretch. QUEEN'S BANE was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late. GOLDEN PURGE was never a threat. DEAL OF A LIFETIME was through after a three quarters. CUT MAN had early speed then retreated. PADISHAH (AZE) was never involved. MR HEAVY was done early. RON STOPPABLE showed little. VIRGIL REALITY was always outrun.
