THANKS BE TO GOD chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch and edged past the leader while holding the final stages. ELLENBERGER PARK stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. MUTAKDDIM'S CROWN was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch but was too late. GARCON pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then took over command in the stretch but yielded late. NORTHERN SWEEPER was back early, angled into the four path in the far turn and flattened out in the stretch run. SIAGON TRAFFIC COP set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and gave way in the stretch drive. MARDI GRAS PARTY was done early. BOLD SPIRIT was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch. OCK MAN was never involved.
