ZAVABELLE stalked the pace into the turn, bid in mid-turn, gained the lead into the lane and was never threatened through the stretch drive while being kept to the task. SHERRY'S TIGER was shuffled through the turn when others went wide, stayed in the two path into the lane and launched a late bid to just get up for the place spot. CLASSIC GAIT was bumped at the start, raced in mid-pack into the turn, bid three wide into the lane, was closest to the winner through the lane, could not gain on that one and lost the place spot in the final step. BRACKETOLOGY was in the three or four path through the turn, bid four wide into the lane and never threatened. NOBLE'S LAST was near the inside into the lane and offered a mild bid. DANCING MARY was in the three or four path into the lane, angled widest for the drive and offered little. DAME NEAR EVEN set the pace into late turn then gave way entering the lane. LIDO POINT tracked the pace along the inside into the turn then faded thereafter.
