Footnotes

EDGERIN J was unhurried early while trailing the field into the far turn, launched a bid from the three or four path through the turn and into the lane and continued on with good energy from mid-track to be up in time. PRACTICAL JUSTICE set a moderately slow pace with a clear lead into the turn, was joined to two others in mid-turn, lost the lead then came back gamely through the lane to regain the front spot and was outfinished. STREAM CAT settled off the pace into the turn, bid three wide to gain a short advantage entering the lane then could not maintain the advantage. MOUNTAIN JUSTICE bid between rivals into the turn then weakened in the drive. FAITHOPE was in the three or four path through the turn and lacked a response in the lane. AZIRULE was never a factor while racing near the inside. FOREVER SURE was close up early then steadily lost ground along the inside.
