**Footnotes**

MISTER CHARMIN was unhurried while along the inside, moved up through the turn, waited for room entering the lane, got clear outside the eighth pole then drove to the front. AUTOCRAT was void of early speed while near the inside, moved quickly through the turn from the two path, continued with good energy into the lane and was closing in. SWISS ICE raced along the inside through the turn,came off the rail for the drive and was slowly gaining. LAZ HAS RISEN raced six wide through the first, remained in the five or six path into the lane, fanned into mid-track for the drive, slowly angled to the rail and offered a mild bid. SHAKE WELL bid entering the far turn from just off the rail, got to the front in the lane then weakened in the critical stages. LIVING BREAD was three wide through the turn when gaining momentum then lacked a response in the lane. HOOSIER REDNECK chased the pace three wide through the turn then tired. UNBRIDLED ZIP pressed the pace from along the rail then faded. OH TRI AVALLI was outrun while going three or four wide. JEFF'SGREENDREAM vied for the lead into the turn then suddenly and quickly dropped back. ARCHAIC threw head at the start,was rank early and bore out through the turn and was far back. JOEANGELO vied for the lead three wide into the turn,dropped back entering the far turn and was pulled up when hopelessly beaten.
