Footnotes

VICTORIA BLU was unhurried early while in the three path through the turn, gained momentum and shifted five wide into the lane, continued with good energy and drove past the pacesetter inside the sixteenth pole. SLACKER vied for the lead along the inside through the turn with two others, shook them off entering the lane and opened a clear advantage, remained well clear with an eighth to go then could not hold off the winner while second best. CHABLACK raced behind a three horse duel through most of the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter pole and into the lane then lacked a closing response while barely holding the show spot. BOOGIEWOOGIEBLUES pressed the pace three wide through the turn and into the lane, weakened from the effort and lost the show spot late. NO SASS was well back through the turn, angled six wide into the lane and moved up while not a threat. ON Z RUN chased the pace from the two path into the lane and was empty in the drive. LA ESCONDIDA was outrun while in the four or five path. KELA'S AMY vied for the lead from between rivals through the turn then faded entering the lane.
