Footnotes

HOOSIER KINGDOM stalked the pacesetters three wide through the turn and into the lane, bid after straightening, inched away from that pair and was all out to last. MOUNTAIN JUSTICE tracked the pacesetters while along the inside into the turn, bid four wide into the lane and was gaining momentum late and just missed. DONT TELL KITTEN vied for the lead from the outset, remained a serious contender inside the eighth pole and was outfinished. ANARKO (CHI) vied for the lead two wide into the lane and weakened inside the sixteenth pole. KENNESSEY was well back into the turn, rallied along the inside into the lane, came off the rail looking for room just inside the eighth pole, waited for a couple of strides and then was hard ridden to the end. RAFE was outrun into the turn, gained momentum in mid-turn, fanned widest for the drive and finished with good energy although belatedly. JIMANATOR chased the pace from the three path and lacked the needed response. THE UNBELIEVABLE was in the five path into the lane and never threatened.
