### Footnotes

THIS SMOKE DID IT vied for the lead two wide into the lane, was on near even terms with a sixteenth to go then put away rival and was never threatened thereafter. WITTY WABBIT vied for the lead along the inside into the lane then yielded to the winner in the final sixteenth and was all out to save the place spot. MOREREADYTHANEVER raced near the two path into the turn, was asked for more in mid-turn and lacked a closing response. WHY GO WEST was unhurried along the inside into the lane, angled widest in the drive and offered a mild bid. TWILIGHTED THISTLE tracked the pace along the inside into the lane then weakened. PREMONT was through early while in the four or five path.
