CENTRE ISLAND dueled with four others through the turn while in the two path, cleared with a furlong to go then held. AWKWARD MOMENT vied for the lead four to five wide through the turn then gained the place spot while not a threat to the winner late. FAMOUS FROLIC vied for the lead five or six wide through the turn then was empty late. CLASSICAL RHYTHM vied for the lead three wide into the lane then weakened inside the eighth pole. IAIN'TMADATCHA set the pace along the inside while under pressure from four others then gave way. LEMONBUSTER tracked behind a five rival duel into the lane then was empty in the drive. MACS ROB ROY was checked near the three-eighths pole when another took his path and had nothing in the lane. HOT JAMBALAYA was in the eight path into the lane and was outrun. RAJON showed brief foot to be close entering the turn then faded. SIR WILLIAM E drifted out in the turn, dropped back and was pulled up and was vanned off.
