JET RAIDER stalked the pace three wide through the turn, caught the leader near the eighth pole then drove past. ROAR OFTHE MISSILE raced along the inside through the turn, came off the rail entering the lane to pass a tiring rival, split rivals to make a serious bid for the lead then could not stay with the winner. COWBOY CHRISTMAS was unhurried through the turn while in the three path then moved up through the lane. MAGIC DE NASKRA bid three or four wide through the turn, fanned into mid-track for the drive and never seriously threatened. GENTLE WILL vied for the lead from the two path into the lane then gave way when challenged near the eighth pole. RUSS THE HOTTIE was in the three path through the turn and never factored. PRINCE DEPUTY raced near the inside into the lane and never factored. GENERAL GLITTER was outrun while in the three or four path through the turn and drifting to the rail through the lane. ARRODYNAMIC pressed the pace along the inside into the lane then retreated.
