X MARKER set the pace while under pressure into the turn, open a clear advantage in mid-turn, continued to widened the advantage into the lane and was kept to the task to the end. SOLD OUT raced along the rail through the turn, came off the inside for the drive and was up for place. REVIVAL RIDGE was in the two path through the turn, remained close the inside for the stretch run and gained the show spot late. PEACENIK chased the pace along the inside into the lane, was closest to the winner with an eighth to go then weakened. I. M. BOOMER was four wide into the lane and lacked a closing bid. MANEKE was never a factor while along the inside. STEVEN vied with the winner two wide into the turn, was still prominent in the lane and faded. THUNDER JACK was in the three path through the turn and came widest into the lane and never was a threat. REDDICK TOWNSHIP vied three wide into the turn then retreated.
